Explore Medicare Plans in Your Area

Enter your ZIP code to see Medicare Advantage plan options available in your area. Compare costs, ratings, and benefits. That includes checking if a plan includes your doctors and your prescriptions.

It's an Easy Ride to Replace Your Card

Always keep your Medicare card in a safe place. But if you happen to lose it, damage it, or if it's stolen—log into your Medicare account to print a new copy.

Go Directly to Your Secure Medicare Account

To manage your Medicare account, head straight to [MyMedicare.gov](https://www.MyMedicare.gov). Track your prescriptions, see services you're eligible for, share information with doctors, and more. It's also the fastest way to check your claims and pay premiums.

Visit [MyMedicare.gov](https://www.MyMedicare.gov). Click "create an account now" or login.

Electronic Medicare Summary Notice (eMSN)

Your eMSN reviews services and medical supplies you received through Medicare Parts A and B in the past three months. Why look? You could catch mistakes in billing, services, and medical supplies. You can also track your monthly claims and costs.

Visit [MedicareSupportCenter.com](https://www.MedicareSupportCenter.com). You'll get an email when your eMSN is ready to view. Then, just log into [MyMedicare.gov](https://www.MyMedicare.gov).

Pay Your Premiums Online

If you pay Part A or Part B premiums, Medicare offers two ways to pay online:

- Fastest: Pay through your Medicare account, using a credit card, debit card, or your checking or savings account.
- or
- Set up Medicare Easy Pay for free, automatic deductions from your checking or savings account every month.

Visit [MyMedicare.gov](https://www.MyMedicare.gov). Select "Pay my premium" to pay now. For Medicare Easy Pay, select "My Premiums," then "Sign Up" to complete a short, online form.

Fuel Up With SilverSneakers

If you have Medicare Advantage (Part C), check if it includes a free membership to SilverSneakers. It's a national program for anyone 65 and older, offering free gym access and online fitness classes, and discounts to nutritionists, physical therapists, and other wellness providers.

Visit [SilverSneakers.com](https://www.SilverSneakers.com). Click "Check My Eligibility." Then, create your account and login.
